Application is hosted in Azure where I setup, configured and maintained the environments, development, UAT and live.

During my time with the Department of Education, I was involved with the implementation of a language service application made available externally, which also involved advising internal staff to maintain and keep the system running smoothly including providing handover documentation.

## Senior SharePoint Developer

### Microsoft via Accenture

FEB 2014 – FEB 2015

I was primarily responsible for the development of a collaborative SharePoint learning portal for new employees joining Microsoft which enabled them to take competency questions which were then reviewed by management in order to track progress. I built the interface, front end and backend for this as well as workflows in C#, Web Parts, CSOM, JavaScript, jQuery, SQL Server and Visual Studio.

I was solely involved in the development of the project from start to finish, working closely with stakeholders, business analysts and project managers to ensure prompt delivery.

I set up the environments, and documented the administration process and maintenance of the sites. Working closely with the Microsoft SharePoint development team I was a key element to using and testing their new Internal SharePoint system what is now known as SharePoint online as this was the first project ever built for SharePoint online!

Also, while working with Accenture, I led a small team for the development of a SharePoint publishing site with approval workflows and web parts for Carlow County Council. This consisted of providing training to personnel in Carlow, as well as mentoring less experienced junior developers within Accenture, and providing an in-depth handover to Carlow County Council's Head of IT.
